## Salvation: A Journey of Walking with God Growing in our salvation: The Means of Growing in Christlikeness Digging Deeper

- 1. Survey through the following passages and discuss the concept of what it means to "be holy."
  - > Eph. 1:3-4
  - > 1 Peter 1:13-16
    - o (Does this sometimes seem to be an impossible goal?)
  - > Heb. 12:10-14
    - o (How holy do we have to be to see God?)
- 2. According to 2 Peter 1:2-4, how has God equipped you to grow in holiness (i.e., Christlikeness)?
- 3. Tony suggested several areas that God has given us to grow, discuss how these help you grow to maturity. Can you grow without these in your life?

Fellowship (Community life), Scripture, Prayer, Worship, Communion (Lord's Table), Serving

- 4. Talk through the seven characteristics that you are to add to your faith according to 2 Peter 1:5-7. How do each of these help in the process of Christlikeness?
- 5. Read 2 Peter 1:8-11 and discuss what Peter means by "make every effort to be sure of your calling and election" in verse 10.
