- The Remnant chosen by grace.  
(11:5-6)
- Many were hardened.  
(11:7-10)
- Why? Gentile inclusion to make Israel jealous.  
(11:11-12)

**The One People of God Illustrated by the Olive Tree**  
11:13-32

**Important Takeaways for our Walk with God**

- Gentile believers have no grounds for pride, rather fear.  
(11:19-22)
- There is a time coming when Jewish people will turn to Jesus  
(11:25-27)
- Don't put God in a box to fit your comfortable theology  
(11:22; 30-32; 33-36 )

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**Digging Deeper into Romans 11**
