The Concept of Christian Freedoms

Principles to Live by:

- → The Glory and Honor of God should be our highest priority Romans 14:6-8; 15:5-7
- \rightarrow God accepts us all so we should do the same for one another. Romans 14:1-4
- $\rightarrow\,$ God is the one who evaluates and judges our lives, we should not do this to one another.

Romans 14:10-11

- → Righteousness, Peace, and Joy are the overarching virtues we should be aspiring for, don't let areas of freedom override these. Romans 14:17-19
- \rightarrow Bearing the burdens of the weak are more important than pleasing ourselves. Romans 15:1-3
