Review of Romans teaching on Salvation

All humanity is lost due to sin Rom. 1:18-3:21

Salvation is by faith in Christ, not by works. Rom. 3:22-4:25

This salvation brings a new identity

Rom. 5 & 8

- From "in Adam" to "in Christ"
- > Children of God
- > Spirit of Adoption
- > Fellow heirs with Christ

The Heart of Romans is "Living a New Life"

- > Death brings New Life
 - o Rom. 6:1-6
- New life equips us for righteous living
 - o Rom. 6:7-14
- Sin is no longer our Master
 - o Rom. 6:6-7, 11-12, 14, 18, 22
