- *discover* who God is and what He has done for us (Isaiah 40; Eph. 1:17-20, 3:14-19; Col. 1:15-23)
- **grow** into Christlikeness (Rom. 8:28-30; Col. 1:27-29, 3:1-17, Phil. 1:6, Gal. 4:19; 1 John 2:28-3:3)
- **engage** a broken world with the hope of the Gospel. (Matt.5:13-16, 28:18-20; Rom. 13:8-10; 1 Pet. 3:14-17;)

With the end result that *God is glorified* in all that we do. (1 Cor. 10:31, Rom. 11:36)

Digging Deeper Study

The 2^{nd} stage of our purpose statement is Growing into Christlikeness. Let's discuss the *Why*, *What*, and *How*.

- 1. Why should this be our goal? Tony stated that this is the reason that God saved you. Read Romans 8:28-30 and discuss what Paul is trying to say about being conformed to Christ's image. What does it mean that Jesus is the "firstborn among many brethren?" If you want to go deeper in understanding how our salvation involves being made like Christ, read and discuss Gal. 4:19, Col. 3:5-14 and Eph. 4:17-24.
- 2. Now let's discuss *what* Christlikeness actually looks like. Ponder the following three areas where we are told to reflect the character of Christ/the Father/the Spirit.
 - ightarrow Fruit of the Spirit

Gal. 5:16, 22-26

→ Increase in Holiness

Matthew 5:48

1 Peter 1:14-16

→ Serving One another.

Matt. 20:25-28
